What is Restoration of Hope?

Restoration of Hope (RoH) began as a dream in the heart of Donatien Nahimana (Honda). After working for 6 years with African Revival Ministries as a driver, administrator and house parent to orphan children, in January 2004 he established Restoration of Hope with a vision to help the street boys of Bujumbura - the capital city of Burundi. Honda's vision was to take boys off the street and to completely change their environment giving them a family, a home, an education and introducing them to a God who has a purpose for their lives - a God who longs to restore their hope!

The project started when Libby (Honda's wife) was followed home by three street boys looking for food. These boys were soon living at the Nahimana's home and were quickly joined by many others who required help.



Boys in RoH receive different levels of care depending on their situation – there are two Hope Houses where some of them live, and they receive everything they need. Some boys have access to one meal a day and a place to wash not only themselves but their clothes and some boys have been reunited with members of their family and RoH continues to help them. However, all of the boys attend school, where possible.

Whilst we can't give you a specific child that your money has helped you will receive two reports from RoH every year and one of these will include an update of how the boys are progressing with their education.

Why education?

One of the biggest challenges RoH face is the cost of educating the 50 or so boys they are helping. Because the boys have been living rough on the streets, some for years, they are all behind in their education by the time they join RoH.

Therefore, to enable them to receive the education they deserve, Honda & Libby made the decision to send them to fee-paying schools. State schools, although free, very often have a ratio of 1 teacher to 90 children, where very little can be learnt, particularly if you have received no education at all.

Without education these boys are caught in the poverty trap.

With education they have HOPE!



So, what can you do?

For one year's education it costs approximately £240 per boy, but it may be that you are not in a position to support the scheme by that amount, so we are offering four different options:-

A) £5 per month

provides uniforms & exercise books for one boy

B) £10 per month

provides school fees for one boy

C) £15 per month

provides school fees, uniforms & exercise books for one boy

D) £20 per month

provides school fees, uniforms, exercise & text books, shoes, sports kit, trainers, school bag & haircuts for one boy
